We would like to welcome Ryan Dean to our coaching staff. We also look forward to Coach Danny arriving from Texas Tech this week.

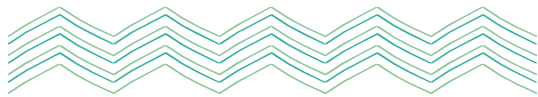
Swim Meet Rules

- All swimmers must check in upon arrival at the swim meet.
- If you will not be able to swim in a meet, you must notify the coaches in writing, (note in the box) by the Tuesday prior to the meet.
- Please note that all relays, except 6 & under, are the **FINAL** events in the meet. If you are scheduled to swim in a relay and are a no show at the meet or leave the meet prior to swimming that event, you will not be entered in a relay for the rest of the season.
- You must compete in two official meets in order to be eligible to compete in the divisional meet.
- If your child is sick and will not be attending the swim meet, please notify Brann Carson by 7:30 a.m. the morning of the meet at 832-656-5640.

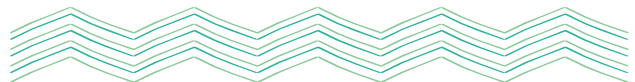
